James Turrell Designs New Space for Kayne Griffin Corcoran

James Turrell will design a new space for Los Angeles gallery Kayne Griffin Corcoran, reports Carol Vogel of the *New York Times*. The new Santa Monica location is ten thousand square feet and was built in the 1940s. Once an auto shop, it is a "beautiful, vaulted space," according to Turrell, who adds that he has devised a system so it can be a "black box, white cube, and everything in between." The gallery will have a permanent installation by Turrell, including one of his famous "skypaces." The new space is set to open May 18 with its first exhibition devoted to forty decades of Turrell's work.
